These are firm deadlines that will permit the distribution of Electronic Proceedings at the Conference. Accepted Papers will be allotted 20 minutes for presentation, and will be reproduced in full (up to 6 pages) in the conference proceedings. IEEE reserves the right to exclude a paper from post-conference distribution (e.g., removal from IEEE Xplore) if the paper is not presented by the author at the conference.
